Kearney is committed to supporting ambitious and driven women to build successful careers in management consulting. With this in mind, we are offering one female student the opportunity to be the Kearney Women's Scholar for 2025 and an intern in one of our Central Eastern European offices.

## Scholarship details

The Kearney Women's Scholarship Program is open to female citizens or permanent residents of a Central Eastern European country (Bucharest, Ljubljana, Prague, Warsaw, or Zagreb) who are university students in or between their second year of undergraduate study and final year of graduate study.

The recipient will be provided with the following:

- Up to €10,000 to be used to support either their next year of study or other education-related activities
- Mentorship from a senior female consultant
- A 10-week internship in one of our Central Eastern European offices (Bucharest, Ljubljana, Prague, Warsaw, or Zagreb)
- Access to all in-house trainings

## How to apply:

To be considered, applicants are asked to submit two items:

1. A one- to two-minute video, responding to the following prompts:
  - Share a time when your values guided your actions and made an impact.
  - Tell us about a person or event that inspired you to pursue your goals and why.

- Forward-thinking and collaborative approach to problem-solving
