Interviews with candidates from countries with higher migration risk – instructions and cooperation with VFS Global

General Information

Applicants to the University of Ljubljana from countries with higher migration risk – that is, countries whose citizens require a Schengen visa – must attend an in-person suitability interview before enrolment, which is preceded by a written mathematics test. Only candidates who successfully pass the written mathematics test will be invited to the interview stage. This structure ensures fair evaluation prior to the application and admission procedure. Some of these interviews will be conducted through VFS Global.

Written Mathematics Test

The test will assess secondary level mathematical knowledge across the following areas: Algebra, Geometry, Functions and Graphs, Trigonometry, and foundational topics in Discrete Mathematics.

Duration: up to 20 minutes.

Candidates must achieve at least 75% correct answers to qualify for the interview.

Interview Stage

Only candidates who score 75% or higher on the mathematics test will be invited to the interview.

The interview assesses:

- motivation for the chosen study programme,
- communication skills,
- understanding of academic expectations.

Duration: up to 10 minutes.

Mode: online video interview, conducted either through the VFS Global or independently.
