We've grown into a respected organisation that works directly with ministries, ambassadors, and universities to address both individual and systemic challenges. More importantly, we've built a platform where other young people are now taking initiative, leading projects, and making their voices heard. Along the way, I've also had the chance to represent students on institutional bodies like the Student council of the School of Economics and Business, the Senate, and the University Student council, contributing to real decisions affecting academic life. Each step has been part of a longer process of becoming who I am today. This entire journey is what I consider my greatest achievement. Not because of any single milestone, but because I chose growth over comfort, and built a meaningful life from the ground up.
